AWARD	Three monetary scholarships; amounts announced with the call for entries. Winners are honored at a reception at the James Monroe House and winning films are screened for members and guests.
ELIGIBILITY	Undergraduate and graduate students enrolled at accredited institutions in DC, Maryland, or Virginia - all majors, community colleges included. No entry fee.
SUBMISSION	A documentary of at least 10 minutes (private or unlisted YouTube link), a written statement, and one faculty recommendation letter.
DEADLINE	February 28, 2027. Entries open October 1, 2026.
